Result: Situation deemed all clear.

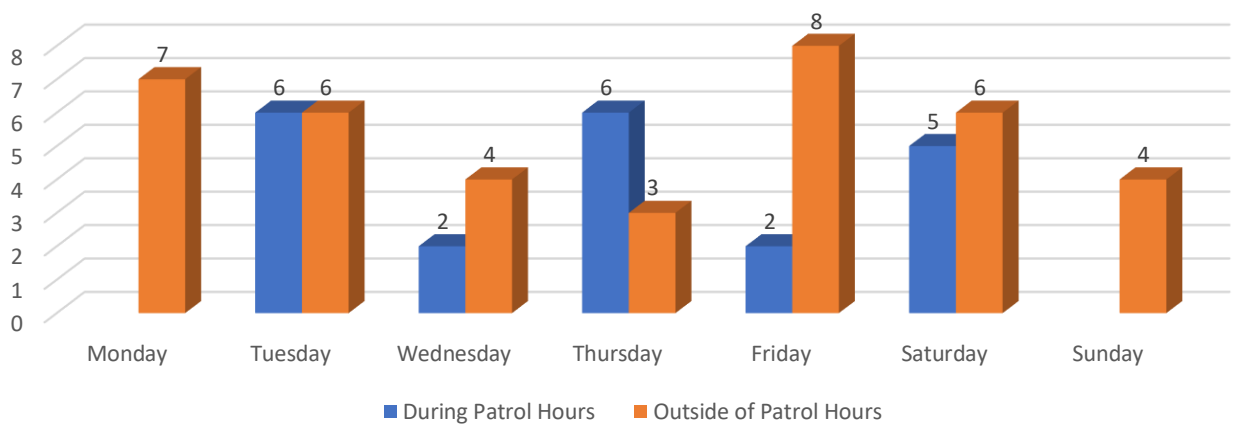
11500 S. Halsted St. (Suspicious Person, Circumstance)

Result: Situation deemed all clear.

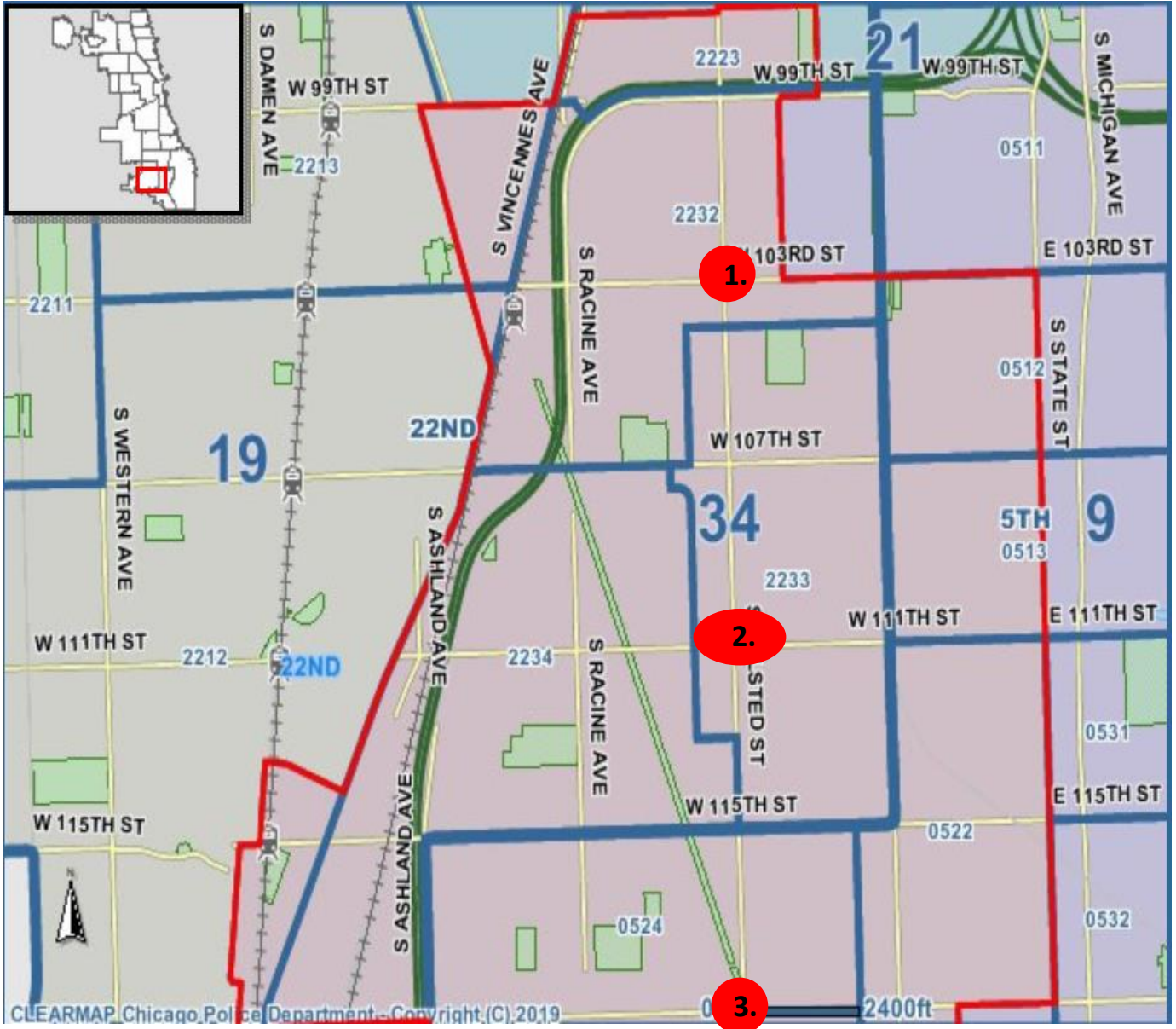
Crime Comparison During Patrol Hours vs. Outside of Patrol Hours



During July, there were 17 more crimes outside of patrol hours than when officers were present in the SSA 45 business district. **There were 38 crimes reported to CPD during July outside of SSA patrol officers' working hours and only 21 nuisance crimes reported while patrol officers were present, showing the impact AGB officers have on the business district on a daily basis.**
